Fourth Annual Picktown Palooza Canceled

Pickerington, OH – To our Visitors, Sponsors, Vendors, Volunteers and Friends:

After careful thought and discussion, the Panger Productions Board of Directors, a non-profit comprised of a group of volunteers, announces the difficult decision to cancel the 2020 Picktown Palooza event, originally scheduled for July 9, 10 and 11 in Historic Downtown Pickerington, Ohio.

For 3 consecutive years, Downtown Pickerington has welcomed the Picktown Palooza the weekend after Fourth of July. We have seen thousands of visitors travel to Pickerington, Ohio for this popular event and enjoy all their favorite food, games, rides, and FREE National Headline Entertainment.

In planning a completely safe event for visitors and volunteers while complying with all of the Governor's orders and restrictions of crowd size and social distancing, safety with food and beverage, and the possibility of not having rides, we have determined that the challenges of holding the 2020 event with this high degree of uncertainty is just beyond our abilities this year.

Thank you to our volunteers who put in countless hours year after year to bring a safe, fun, and family-oriented community event to all who attend. We also thank our city, township, and county government officials and our many food vendors and corporate sponsors for their support over the years.

The Panger Productions Board will be back next year to present **The Event of the Summer** for our entire community and beyond. The 4th Picktown Palooza is now scheduled for the week after the fourth of July in 2021.
